WHICH BUILDINGS ARE SUBJECT TO COMPLIANCE?

All buildings 5-stories or greater in height.

ACCEPTABLE INSPECTORS

Competent persons—this may be restoration contractor with documented experience, an established inspection service, an architect, or an engineer.

EXTERIOR WALLS SUBJECT TO INSPECTION

All roof-mounted structures and every exterior wall of or part of the building's exterior, including connecting bridges, cornices, copings, sills, bays, or similar projections

METHOD OF INSPECTION

A thorough visual inspection by a competent person. Note that the BSEED may require inspection openings where the conditions of a structure or wall cannot be determined by visual inspection only.
